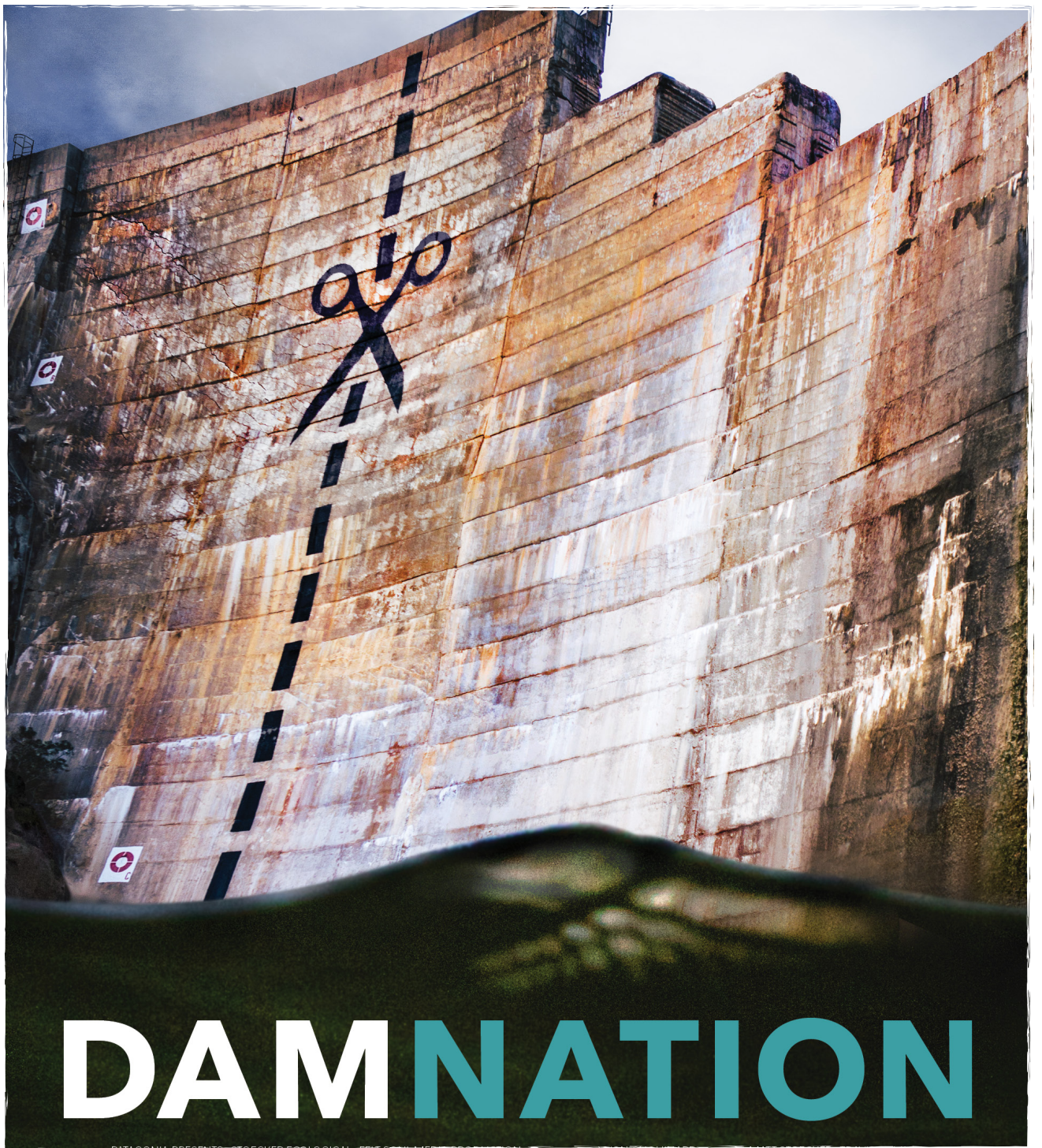

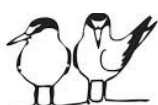

PARKING AND DIRECTIONS:

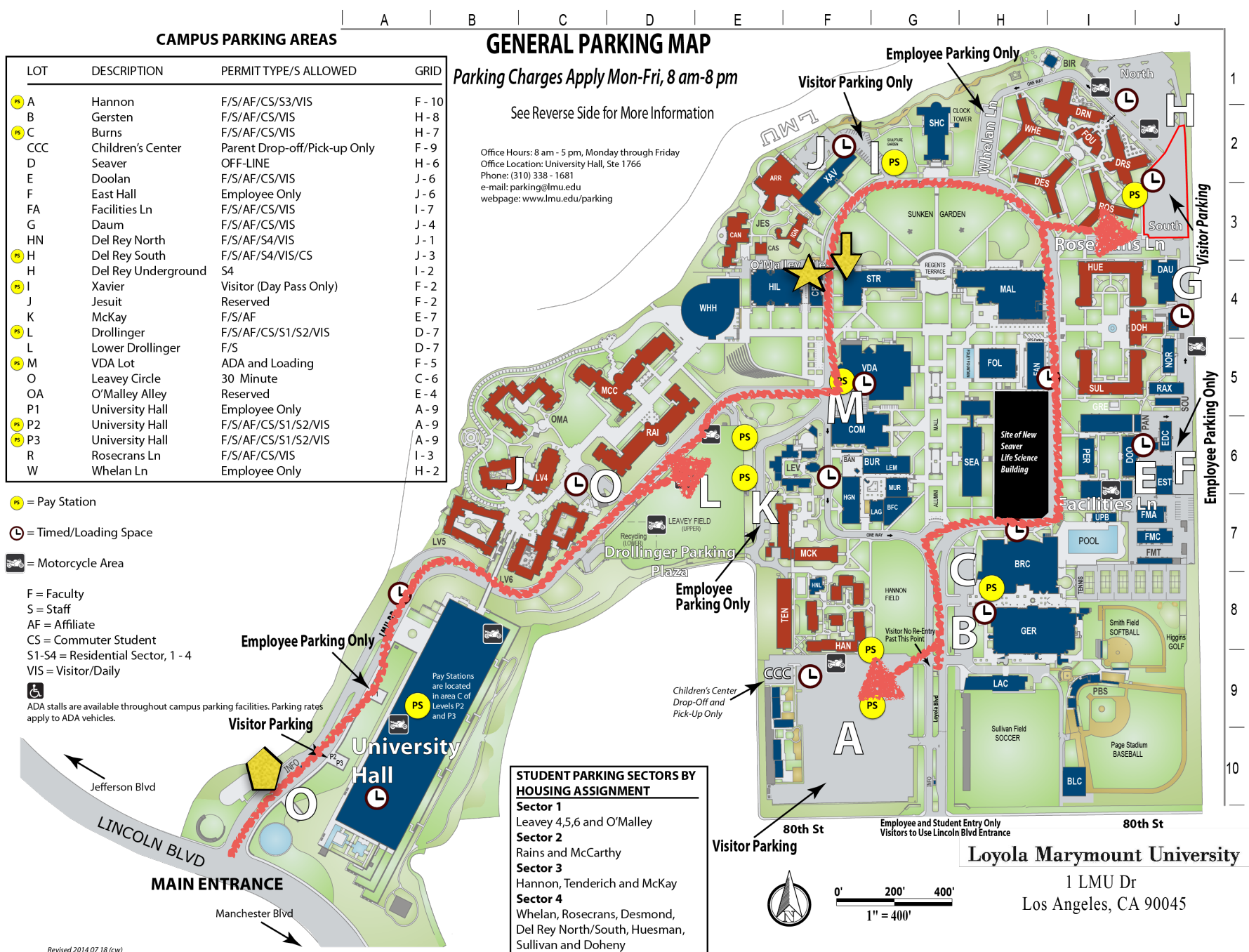
The Networking event will be located in the Hilton 300 room. Parking is located in the Drollinger (L on the map) and Hannon lots (A on the map). Attached is a map of the LMU campus that points out the parking entrance and both preferred parking lots. An information booth/security kiosk is located in the Lincoln Blvd entrance (1 LMU Drive, Los Angeles, CA 90045) the security officer there will hand you a map of parking instructions and directions if you ask about the event.

There are two ways to pay for parking: Parkmobile or a pay station on-site in the parking structure. All day parking is \$10. Parkmobile (<http://us.parkmobile.com/>) is an easy to use payment system. Download their smartphone app (<http://us.parkmobile.com/mobile-apps>), enter user info, vehicle license plate, payment information, and the LMU campus code "961". This can be done in advance. Here is the parkmobile QR code for your convenience:



To encourage people to bike to the event and avoid to the parking fee there will be a complimentary bike valet located directly across the street from Hilton at the west end of St. Robert's Auditorium. Security will be present at the bike valet throughout the entire event.

From the parking lot, refer to the map below to find Hilton. An elevator is located outside in the breezeway on the east side of the building (the star on the map). This elevator will take you directly to the event in Hilton 300.
