

Thank you for helping with the Malibu Lagoon Restoration! You're signed up – please follow the directions below.

About the Malibu Lagoon

Between the summer of 2012 and spring 2013, Malibu Lagoon underwent a restoration process to improve the health of the ecosystem at the Lagoon, which had long been labeled an “impaired” water body by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. The Lagoon was filled in by excess sediment and suffered from low dissolved oxygen levels within the channels, which threatened fish and wildlife. The restoration removed contaminated soil and trash built up over decades and re-contoured the western channels to improve water flows and circulation. Now we need your help to help maintain and to improve the site.

When

Saturday, November 19, 2016 from 10 AM to 1 PM

Location

From PCH northbound, make a left at Cross Creek Road and park in the lot ([GOOGLE MAP](#)). Use 3999 Cross Creek Road, Malibu, CA 90265 for GPS navigation purposes.

Parking

Anywhere in the lot, but be sure get a parking pass from site supervisor Mark Abramson or from CA State Parks personnel.

Bring

Water, sunscreen, a snack if desired, and wear closed-toed shoes. Tools and gloves provided.
