About

The once mighty Stone Canyon Creek used to be a dominant feature of the UCLA campus. Over the years, as the campus expanded, the creek was routed underground, and today only a small segment runs through the UCLA Lab School campus and behind the Anderson School of Management. The vegetation that persists at the creek site is dominated by invasive plants which are overtaking and pushing the few remaining native plant and wildlife species. *Help us eliminate this infestation of invasive vegetation, replant the area with native vegetation, and restore this all but lost ecosystem.*
