

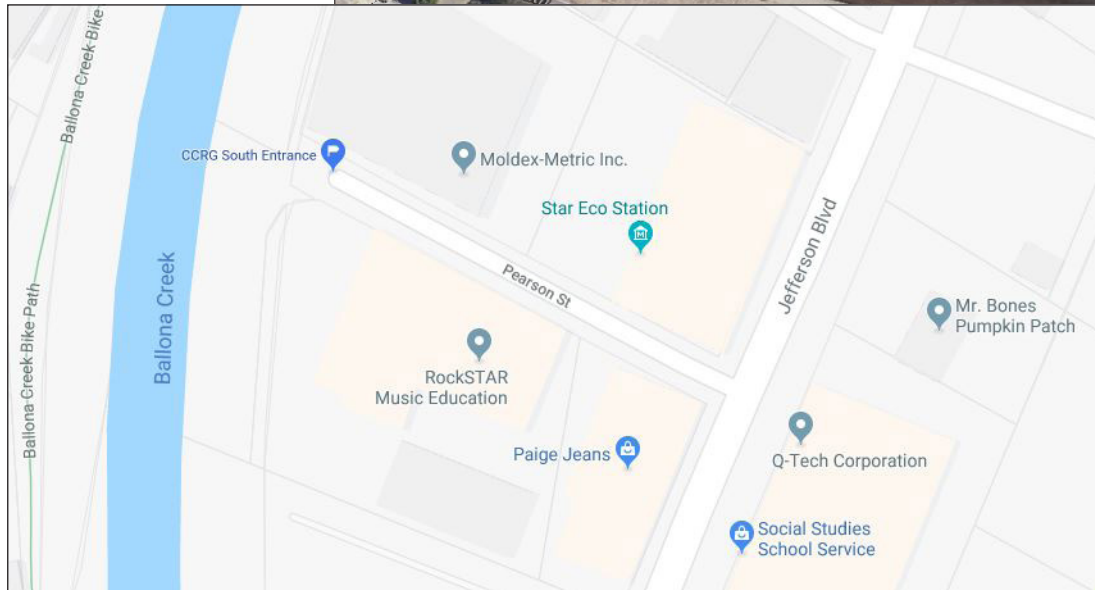
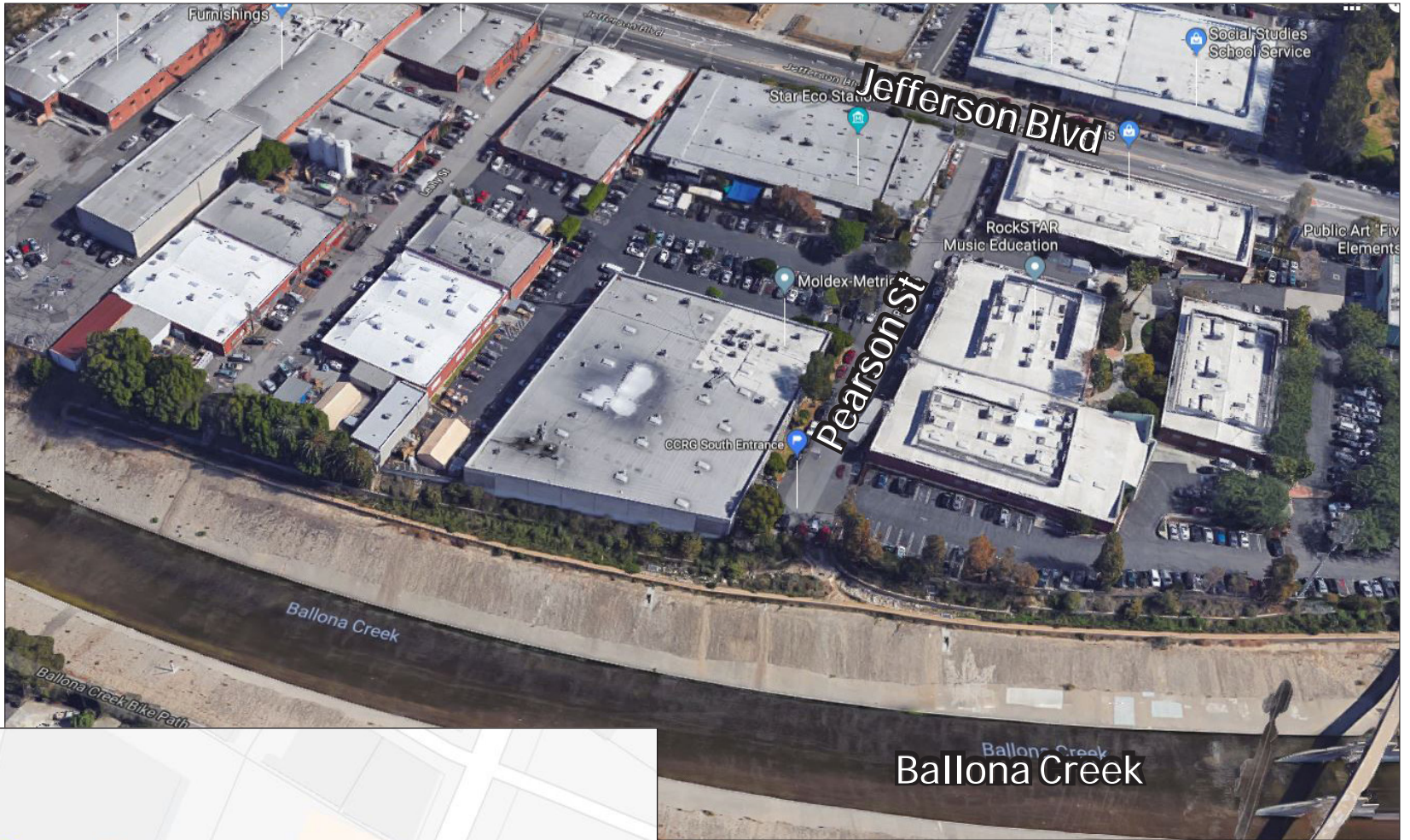


The Culver City Rain Garden was designed to capture rain and surface runoff, filter noxious contaminants that would otherwise flow into the Ballona Creek.

To enhance its use and aesthetic appeal, drought-tolerant native plants line its banks which attracts native bugs and birds.

Dedicated volunteers regularly come to the CCRG and remove non-native vegetation that can negatively impact the garden.
